



APPLETON AIRPORT ADDS MORE FLIGHTS FOR NFL DRAFT

United Airlines adds flights for April 2025 event

A major airline serving the Appleton International Airport (ATW) announces it will be expanding existing routes to accommodate visitors for the 2025 draft April 24-26 in Green Bay.

United Airlines will add flights to ATW for the draft which are:

- A flight from Houston (IAH) was added daily Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday of the draft.
- A second Denver (DEN) flight was added to the existing regularly scheduled flight on the same days.

Appleton airport officials previously announced these carriers were expanding service for the days surrounding the draft:

- American Airlines will add flights from Phoenix, AZ (PHX), Dallas/Ft. Worth, TX (DFW) and Charlotte, NC (CLT)
- Delta Airlines will add an additional flight from Atlanta, GA (ATL)
- Allegiant Airlines will add new service to Pittsburgh, PA (PIT), Providence, RI (PVD) and Canton/Akron, OH (CAK). They will also add to their existing schedule for St. Petersburg/Clearwater, FL (PIE), Orlando/Sanford, FL (SFB), Punta Gorda, FL (PGD), Sarasota/Bradenton, FL (SRQ), Phoenix/Mesa, AZ (AZA), New York/Newark (EWR), Las Vegas, NV (LAS), Denver, CO (DEN), Nashville, TN (BNA)
- In total, four flights will be added and 10 routes will be expanded for the draft.

“We expect our passenger traffic will effectively double over usual traffic at this time,” said Appleton Airport Director Abe Weber. “We’re excited to welcome national and international passengers to Northeast Wisconsin through Appleton where they will find a fast, easy, and more convenient way to travel to the draft.”

Weber adds that the first phase of the major terminal expansion will be close to completion in time for the draft, with all 10 gates available for increased air traffic.
