APPLETON INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT INCREASES NONSTOP FLIGHT OPTIONS TO WARM WEATHER DESTINATIONS FOR SPRING BREAK 2019

APPLETON, Wis., Feb. 28, 2019 - [Appleton International Airport](#) will offer more flights than ever before in March and April to give spring break travelers more options from Appleton.

"Nothing is more exciting after a long winter than heading somewhere warm for spring break," said Abe Weber, airport director. "At ATW we're offering more flights and destinations than ever before during March and April in order to make sure there's plenty of options for travelers looking to escape the Wisconsin cold."

In March, Appleton's increased schedule offers five weekly flights to Orlando/Sanford, four weekly flights to Phoenix/Mesa, as well as two weekly flights to Tampa/St. Pete, Fort Myers/Punta Gorda and Las Vegas. The airport serves Northeast Wisconsin via four airlines (American Airlines, Delta Air Lines, United Airlines and Allegiant Air) with nonstop service to 10 destinations including five major hubs (Atlanta, Chicago, Denver, Detroit, Minneapolis/St. Paul) and five warm weather destinations (Fort Myers/Punta Gorda, Las Vegas, Orlando/Sanford, Phoenix/Mesa and Tampa/St. Pete).
