The biggest gains come from American Airlines, which will fly 90% of its pre-COVID-19 schedule beginning July 7. In addition to a strong leisure customer demand, northeast Wisconsin businesses have started traveling again, prompting more flight options.

Allegiant Air, with its focus on vacation destinations, is already seeing travel returning to normal. "Our Allegiant flights are very popular since travelers can fly nonstop from Appleton with low fares," said Abe Weber, Appleton Airport director.
