

AMERICAN AIRLINES ANNOUNCES NEW NONSTOP SERVICE FROM APPLETON TO CHARLOTTE

APPLETON, Wis. (September 8, 2020) — American Airlines introduces service from Appleton Airport to Charlotte Douglas International Airport (CLT) beginning November 5, 2020.

Travelers will enjoy the vibrant arts, culture, and history of Charlotte, and the new flight will also offer convenient connections to over 50 cities in the southeast, including 10 Caribbean/Mexican destinations, along with over 15 cities in Florida.

"We understand Wisconsin's love of warm weather destinations," said Brian Znotins, American's Vice President of Network Planning. "We're delighted to add Appleton service to our Charlotte hub, to support Appleton Airport's mission to seamlessly connect its customers to the world."

The new flight will operate daily, departing Appleton at 7:00 a.m., arriving in Charlotte at 10:20 a.m. The return flight departs Charlotte at 8:00 p.m., arriving in Appleton at 9:06 p.m.

Customers will enjoy American's 76-seat Embraer E-175, a modern regional jet that feels like a larger jet, and includes 12 first class seats. The flight is currently planned as a seasonal route running through April and is now available for bookings at <u>aa.com</u>.

"Wisconsin travelers will have access to all the great destinations available through American's Charlotte hub." said Abe Weber, Appleton airport director. "Charlotte is American's gateway to the Southeast, Florida and the Caribbean, so getting to these popular destinations will now be faster and easier for our customers."
